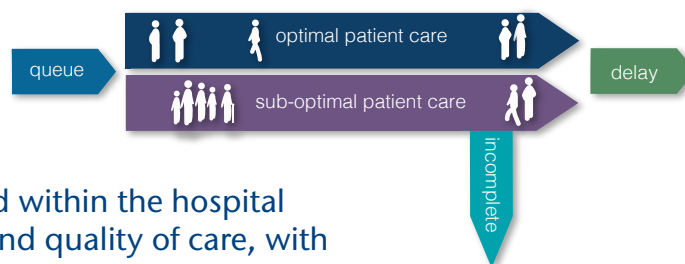


Implementing Criteria Led Discharge in Scotland

Delays in discharge are a key blockage identified within the hospital system. These delays impact on patient safety and quality of care, with patients' length of stay extended due to delays in decision-making and a 'wait culture' in place across the system. Nationally, we are promoting the use of criteria led discharge to reduce these delays.

This national event will bring together colleagues from across Scotland to share and develop the knowledge and skills needed to successfully implement criteria led discharge.

The day will provide an opportunity to share best practice, including presentations from across Scotland and England. The keynote speaker will be Liz Lees, Clinical Doctoral Research Fellow with National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) and Consultant Nurse in Acute Medicine at Heart of England NHS Trust, who is internationally renowned for her research of criteria and nurse led discharge.
